| <p>1) False. The batter is not out since the third strike was not legally caught before touching the ground. He may attempt to reach first base.</p> <p>2) True. He is awarded two bases from the last base he legally occupied at the time of the throw. R1 must still return to first base to tag up before proceeding to the awarded bases.</p> <p>3) False. This is not a catch because he fell immediately following the catch which caused him to drop the ball. The batter is not out.</p> <p>4) False. An attempted bunt cannot be ruled an infield fly.</p> <p>5) False. This is NOT umpire interference. The run scores.</p> <p>6) True. The ball is declared "dead" and the runner is returned to his previous base.</p> <p>7) False. The batter failed to reach first base safely which made this out a force out.</p> <p>8) True. Runner must avoid contact with the fielder.</p> <p>9) True. R1 is out at second.</p> <p>10) False.
